### Friday October 1

At 3:00 we will meet at the Heaven Hill distillery for a Bourbon tour. The last tour of the day starts at 3:30. The address of the Bourbon Heritage Center for Heaven Hill is 1311 Gilkey Rum Road in Bardstown. This is an optional event and no charge.

At 6:30 we will be meeting at Buffalo Wings & Rings for our Friday night gathering. The address for this is 1012 Granite Dr (intersection of US-62 and KY-245). This is a pay for your own food and drinks and it is an optional event.

### Saturday October 2

At 10:15 we will be meeting at the Kentucky Railroad Museum. The address of the museum is the 136 Main Street in New Haven Kentucky. We are leaving at 11:00 for a 90 minute train excursion and admission to the museum.
