

Crews Clear Derailed Cars

Railroad repair gangs restored traffic early last night after working more than 12 hours clearing a Monon Railroad right of way near Carmel where 17 cars of an Indianapolis-bound freight train left the tracks at 6:30 a.m.

All five crewmen on the train escaped injury.

The pile-up was blamed on a broken draw bar under coupling between two cars. It dropped onto the track, flipping over one grain-filled car and derailling 16 others.
